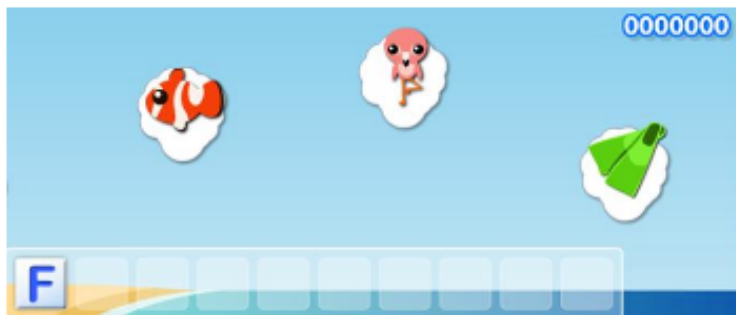

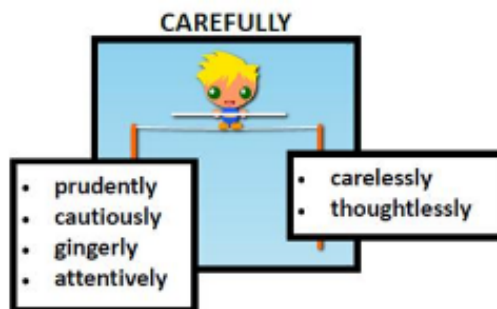
New Activity - Kerpoof Spellbound!

[Kerpoof Spellbound](#) prompts students to add characters and objects to a background, much like Make a Picture. The twist? In order to add a new object, they have to spell it first. To get started, enter the activity and select a scene. A background will appear, along with ABC tiles that can be dragged, clicked, or typed into position in order to spell a word. When a word is spelled correctly, the user can click on the object to bring it into the scene! Try typing in actions, like **jump**, **chat**, or **twirl**. Did you find a word we missed?
