Students become historians in this new lesson plan, using Kerpoof's Thanksgiving scenes in Make a Picture. We've written two plans: [one for grades 2-4](#), and [another for grades 5-8](#). In the younger version, students perform a KWL activity around the history of Thanksgiving. In the older version, students learn the difference between primary and secondary texts, encountering some of the historical documents associated with Plymouth Colony and the First Thanksgiving.
